

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY
October 7, 2015

In attendance: Select Board –Duane Vigue and Berkley Linscott; CEO – Bob Temple; Public: Cathy Blake, Jane Carroll, Lynn Carroll

Duane Vigue called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the summary from 09/30/2015 as written, Duane Vigue seconded, all in favor.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the warrants as written \$6,283.60/payroll (includes overtime for roads crew to fix storm damages) and \$145,332.87/vendor (includes Knox County tax), Duane Vigue seconded, all in favor. Warrants read, approved, and signed.

Duane Vigue reported on Public Works Report – 9/28 brought P500 to Cushing Diesel for work to be done; 9/29 marked roads for grading, picked up truck parts; 9/30 worked on the P200 & P300 doing maintenance; 10/1-10/3 patched roads from the wash outs. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Duane Vigue seconded, all in favor.

Bob Temple, as CEO, reported he issued one permit for a yurt and finishing permits for a few lake properties.

Treasurer/Town Clerk - None.

The Junkyard permits were signed after the inspections on Monday. Ron Jackson, Route 17, has some issues with DEP that he is cleaning up. The stipulation was put in his permit before he can proceed. Kathy Blake asked what they look for in an inspection. Duane Vigue explained they look for oil spills where they do not belong, check the berm around the junkyard to make sure nothing is stored on the other side, make sure the salvage is being done correctly.
