

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY  
November 25, 2015

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Duane Vigue and Berkley Linscott;  
Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public: Donald L. Grinnell, Christopher Armstrong

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the summary from 11/18/2015 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the warrants as written \$3,502.56/payroll (signed on Tuesday because of the holiday) and \$5,042.60/vendor Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor. Warrants read, approved, and signed.

Wesley Daniel reported on Public Works Report –11/16 – 11/19 Two crew member's worked on stock piling winter sand the third crew member worked in the shop, worked on the heater on P300, rotated tires on P300, changed oil and filters and changed transmission oil and filters and greased the back hoe. Duane Vigue moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Bob Temple reported that he and Wesley Daniel met at Steinmeyer's and will meet again next Friday. Steinmeyer is having someone come in to clean. All the gravel pits are inspected except Dave's World. Because the pit is licensed by the state, Bob will send a letter regarding Sukeforth's pit failing to comply with the local ordinance now considered abandoned. Bob will contact the chairperson of the Mining Ordinance Committee to reconvene for clarification on what abandonment means.

Treasurer/Town Clerk – Ann Dean sent the paperwork in for the truck loan (2.75% for 8 years through The First). Ann asked the Selectmen to sign the 60 day letter for the three automatic foreclosure's which will be sent certified. She also asked Berkley Linscott to hand deliver one as they don't have a mailbox and have not paid for their post office box.

Donald Grinnell asked for permission to spend down the \$109.00 in the Veteran's Flag Account. He would like to purchase 14 plastic flag holders including shipping (\$107.00). He also asked that the budget be increased from \$500.00 to \$750.00 for next year. Donald also had the map to Davis Cemetery which had been recorded in 1984. He will try to update the list.

Wreaths Across America will be at Medomak Valley High School on Sunday, December 6 from 2-3 to present a wreath to the town. Wesley Daniel and Donald Grinnell will be there to represent Washington.

Donald Grinnell suggested the town purchase a tripod for the wreath for the center of town.
