

Selectmen//Assessor's Meeting Summary  
February 3, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Duane Vigue, and Berkley Linscott: Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public: Tom Johnston

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the summary from 1/27/16 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the warrant as written \$3,543.12/payroll and \$8,716.18/vendor, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – Wesley reported for 01/24 – 01/31 picked up new plow truck in Skowhegan, worked in shop, put new cutting edges on new plow, put new cable on P500 for wing control, and sanded the roads. Duane Vigue moved to accept the report as read, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – None

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – Ann Dean reported that she will be writing down all extra work that is being done. There was some confusion with a bank regarding a quit claim deed which Ann has all the paperwork to back up the town's interest. Ann sent the Public Hearing Notice for 2/16 to the Courier. Red Cross is not on the Warrant this year because, after several phone calls, a petition was not received. Chris Armstrong and Tom Johnston have turned in their papers for the 1 year Selectmen's position. A lot of work was done on the Town Meeting Warrant. Ann called the auditors to find out when they would be coming. \$3,500.00 was collected for the purchase of the old plow truck.

Due to inclement weather Jason Seiders, Inland Fisheries & Wildlife, was not able to attend this meeting. He is scheduled to be here next week.

After some discussion the Selectmen decided against the Speed Trailer Loan Program.

Wesley Daniel opened the discussion regarding fuel prices (State 2.95/gal wo fed tax; Maritime Energy 2.29.2/gal w/fed tax). After discussion it was decided that, at this time in most cases, the fuel will be purchased from Maritime Energy and Ann Dean will complete the paperwork for federal tax reimbursement. They also discussed the regulations about having a gas tank at the town garage.

Questions and Comments

Wesley Daniel attended an ambulance meeting today. Our payment will be \$12,466. They will have two people there during the day as a trial and the pay for that will come out of their reserves.

Duane Vigue explained the oil price email that had been sent to the Selectmen today from Andrew Hart. He is looking to lock in prices for us at or below \$1.65/gal within a week. He is asking if we are interested in committing. Wesley Daniel and Berkley Linscott agreed to commit to locking us in within the week. Duane will contact Andrew to lock in and request paperwork. Ann Dean will print the email.

Duane Vigue asked Tom Johnston what happens to the Fire Chief and EMA Director positions while he runs for Selectmen. If Tom is elected as Selectmen those positions become vacant. The Fire Department Board of Director's recommends a name to become Chief and the Chief appoints his Deputy.

The Select Board has the preliminary Town Meeting Warrant and the Selectmen's write up for the Town Report to review, and make any changes and/or corrections. The deadline for Town Report information is February 24.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 7:33PM.
