

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY**  
**March 7, 2012**

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the February 29, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$5,244.67 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$261,927.66. The vendor warrant included a \$250,000 withdrawal from Camden National Bank which was deposited into Machias Savings Bank as the town transfers its banking accounts to Machias Savings Bank.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was present and provided a written report of his activities March 1 – 7. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report. Frank reported that he has found four used truck rims at White & Bradstreet in Augusta to replace broken rims on the plow trucks.

Bob Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve an pole application from Central Maine Power Co on the Vanner Road.

At 6:30 pm on Tuesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, the selectmen and members of the Roads Committee will attend a briefing on a new pavement process by Chip Seal Inc. The briefing will be held jointly with the Union board of selectmen at the Union town office.

The selectmen will meet with a representative from the Maine Municipal Association Casualty & Risk Pool to review the town's insurance policies.

The selectmen and town clerk discussed possible replacement of the copier in the town office. Ann will gather more information before a decision is made.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:23 pm
