

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
May 30, 2012

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the May 23, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$2,970.34 and a accounts payable warrant in the amount of \$112,452.29 (includes the MSAD 40 monthly assessment of \$102,221.12) which left a balance of \$100,000 in the operating account and \$208,848.22 in the interest bearing sweep account. The selectmen reviewed the TRIO General Ledger, Revenue and Expense reports dated May 30th.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was present and provided a written report of his activities May 21 – 30.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report. The CEO has issued a Stop Work Order" for a gravel pit and rock crusher operation on the McDowell Road until the owner obtains a permit from the planning board.

The selectmen voted unanimously to appoint Liane Chapman, Judson Buttermann, and David Martucci to the Mining Ordinance Review Committee.

The selectmen approved the roadside mowing bid and directed Don to post it with the weekly selectmen's meeting summary.

The selectmen approved and directed Don to post the notice of a public hearing on proposed amendments Appendices A, B, and C to the Washington General Assistance Ordinance scheduled for Wednesday, June 13, 2012, at 7:00 pm in the Bryant Room of the Gibbs Library. The Maine State Legislature voted to revise limits on various general assistance limits, thus requiring amendment of local ordinances.

Don announced that the fuel oil contract had been locked in with the Knox County bid at \$3.15 per gallon for the upcoming winter season.

The selectmen and road commissioner discussed paving of town roads for this year but made no decision. They will meet residents of Lincoln Road at 6:00 pm on Wednesday, June 6, 2012, to discuss the condition of the Lincoln Road.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:35 pm.
