

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY
January 21, 2015

The weekly selectmen's and assessor's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm , Wednesday, January 21, 2015 by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the January 14, 2015, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$5,153.47 and an accounts payable warrant of \$7,396.11.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was present and discussed the following issues with the selectmen:

- 1) The town clerk had received a Freedom of Information request via email from Patrick Mallor, attorney for Berkley and Nancy Linscott seeking all documents relating to the reclamation plan submitted by Scott Braley, engineer for the Linscott's. The documents were gathered and will be sent certified mail tomorrow (January 22nd) less any documents which reflected discussions between the municipal officials and the town attorney regarding the Linscott case.
- 2) The selectman received a copy of the final judgment in the case of Town of Washington vs. Robert Steinmeyer.
- 3) Bob will be sending Willard Pierpont a letter stating that the old gravel pit owned by Mr. Pierpont off the Vanner Road is considered reclaimed. The pit has been idle for several years,

William Brewer, auditor for the town, and his staff will begin the audit of the 2014 financial records on Thursday, January 29th. The selectmen will be present for the start of the audit at 8:00 am.

The selectmen signed quit claim deeds for properties located on Map 7 / Lot 52 and Map 14 / Lot 04. The parcels had been foreclosed upon by the town for unpaid taxes. As authorized at the annual town meeting, the selectmen offered the parcels back to the previous owner for all back taxes, interest, and fees, which were paid by the previous owner.

After being brought before the board again for discussion, the selectmen signed a letter of support to the RSU 40 school board in support of establishing a varsity football program at Medomak Valley High School.

The selectmen and town treasurer completed work on the draft municipal budget for 2015. They will conduct a final review next week. At 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 4th the selectmen will present the 2015 municipal budget to the budget committee in the Bryant Room. The selectmen will hold its weekly meeting at 6:00 pm that evening instead of the normal starting time.

The selectmen discussed asking the town to authorize the purchase of a new plow truck at the annual town meeting. Wes will try to get a sales rep from H.P. Fairfield to attend the next selectmen's meeting to gather information.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 8:03 pm.
