

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING
October 1, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Duane Vigue with Selectman Donald Grinnell also in attendance. Selectman Wesley Daniel was absent.

The summary of the September 24, 2014, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$2,733.53 and an accounts payable warrant of \$17,970.58 that included the annual payment to Union Ambulance of \$10,853.97. The selectmen received the TRIO revenue and expense reports dated October 1st. After this week's warrants were paid, an online balance of municipal accounts held at Machias Saving Bank indicated \$100,000.00 in the operating account and \$811,592.43 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Taxes were due and payable today. Any taxes received after this date will be assessed interest. No additions to the Tax Club will be accepted after this date.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities for the period Sept 21-27. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was present and briefed the selectmen on the following:

- 1) Bob has been in contact with Troy Hatch regarding the proposed body shop on the Hatch property at 136 Waldoboro Road. Maine DEP has completed its survey under the Well Protection Program. Bob has sent Mr. Hatch a copy of the DEP map that showed the proposed site is within the 1000' limit for the public wellhead at the school. Mr. Hatch has verbally indicated to Bob that he will be withdrawing his application, but no written notice has been received.
- 2) Bob and the Selectmen will be meeting in the law offices of Paul Gibbons who will act as the court appointed mediator between the town and Berkley and Nancy Linscott regarding a land use violation. The mediation meeting will be Thursday, October 9th at 9:30 am in Camden.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 7:16 pm.
