

**SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY**  
**December 23, 2014**

With the regularly scheduled weekly selectmen and assessors meeting falling on Christmas Eve the rescheduled weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, December 23, 2014 by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the December 17, 2014, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3,794.92 and an accounts payable warrant of \$115,753.87 that included the monthly RSU 40 assessment of \$107,960.53.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent and had no written report.

The selectmen voted unanimously to appoint Ann Dean as Registrar of Voters and Mary Anderson as Deputy Registrar of Voters.

The selectmen voted unanimously to set the date for municipal elections as March 27, 2015 and the open portion of town meeting as March 28, 2015.

The selectmen noted receipt of a \$4,000 check from the attorney representing Berkley and Nancy Linscott as payment of the from the negotiated consent agreement for the Linscott's unpermitted gravel pit on McDowell Road. Also received was a reclamation plan from the Linscott's engineer/surveyor. The selectmen determined that the reclamation plan did not meet the requirements stipulated in the consent agreement. They voted unanimously to reject the reclamation plan.

Wes and Don briefed Duane on a recent General Assistance case that was handled with short notice.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 7:32 pm.
