The weekly selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:00 by Selectman Wes Daniel. Selectman Duane Vigue was in attendance with selectman Don Grinnell absent.

A citizen that was using the Crystal Lake pull off damaged their car and is asking the town for repair costs. Selectman Wes Daniel will contact MMA to discuss our responsibilities.

Ben Ketchen from Machias Savings Bank would like to meet with the Select Board to discuss renewal of our existing line of credit.

Wes is completing the LRAP certification for proper use of funded monies.
