

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
January 4, 2017

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple Public – Kit Lascoutx

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the summary from 12/28/2016 as written, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$6,237.58/payroll, \$15,561.75 /vender, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 12/25 – 12/31 plowed and sanded, mixed sand and salt with the grizzly, repaired wing arm on P200. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Reports as read, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob Temple reported that he is working on the finding of fact on a subdivision for the Planning Board. Bob will consolidate all his 2016 permits and correspondence onto a CD for backup to be stored in the town office. Tom Johnston asked if there has been an application for a subdivision. Bob said yes, a small subdivision.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – Ann Dean reported that she closed the books in TRIO on 12/31. She emailed the Budget Committee the 2016 reports, mailed to Dorothy Sainio. Stanley Millay has been in working on the maps. Ann and Mary Anderson are signed up for a Vitals class in Augusta. She sent all the detailed and summary reports to the auditors so they can start the audit. Tom Johnston (Selectmen) and Guy Bourrie (School Board) have both taken out their papers that are due back on February 6th. Ann did a Quit Claim Deed for the Selectmen to sign off on a 1982 unreleased deed. Sandra Patrick came in to fill out all her paperwork for the Comprehensive Plan Secretary. Union Ambulance thanked the Washington Fire Department and Washington Public Works for their recent assists.

Wesley Daniel moved to sign Quit Claim Deed for lien release for Map 08 Lot 04, from 1982, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.
