

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary  
March 21, 2018

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public –Traci Hoffman

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 03/14/18 with corrections, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$6,173.08/payroll; \$152,554.86/vendor (includes school payment of \$128,850.00), Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 3/11 – 3/17: 12<sup>th</sup> - worked in garage, put lights on P-100 & P-200, greased P-500, got ready for storm; 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> – plowed and sanded; 15<sup>th</sup> - plowed and sanded, changed cutting edges on P-200. Time cards attached.

CEO Report – Bob Temple stated he received the letter to Daryl Flagg, regarding the old Sinclair pit, from Peter Drum. The Selectmen read and approved to mail, with corrections. Next year, if a pit inspection fee is not paid by the end of the year it will be considered abandoned. The Selectmen asked Bob to send a letter to Tim Jackson stating, to be in compliance, he needs to move all tires to the approved area or container after the snow melts. Bob issued a building and plumbing permit, to add a bathroom, for Fishlips.

Town Clerk/Treasurers Report – Ann Dean reported that Mary Anderson did the payroll warrant this week she was also here for the Worker's Comprehensive Audit, Monday, which went very well. We did receive Jim Brann's Worker's Comp Certificate. Ann trained Mary on doing journal entries and adding and delete accounts; she be available for any questions. Ann went to The First yesterday after receiving an email from the auditor on how much to remove from the CD. Ann withdrew \$1,896.00 out of the trust fund and deposited it to the general fund check book. We're prepared for Town Meeting.
