

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
April 5, 2017

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; CEO – Bob Temple; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public – Kit Lascoux, Traci Hoffman, Kathleen Ocean, Denise Hylton

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 03/29/17 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$5,005.83/payroll, \$4,531.53/vender Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 3/26 – 4/1: 27th – sanded roads 14 hours with the extra driver for 4 hours (2 regular drivers); 28th sanding roads 10.5 with the extra driver for 4 hours. 29th picked up parts in Augusta for P300, new rotor seal bearings/repared same, fueled up 8 hours. 30th cutting edges on plow wing P300, got trucks ready for storm. 1st plowed and sanded with back up driver 8.5 hours. CEO Report – Bob Temple stated the Advent Camp will be replacing their dining hall. Bob also included a copy of a permit for the fire marshal. He is also getting ready to do the mining inspections by June 1.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – Ann Dean stated the Worker's Comp Audit was done yesterday, which went well. The lien certificates will go out tomorrow, 101. Denise Hylton will start working in the town office tomorrow.

Tom Johnston moved to sign the Assessor's Return for County Tax, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel stated the town received a check for \$2,000.00 through the Safety Enhancement Grant Award for turnout gear which was put in May, 2016.

Wesley Daniel stated he is still waiting for a call back from Paul Gibbons regarding Doe Mill Road.

Ann Dean will sign the Road Crew up for a workshop on May 9 through Maine Local Roads Center.

Salt bids were discussed. Delivered price; pick up price respectively. Morton Salt 58.39; 58.00 NE Salt Co. 60.13; 60.00 Harcos Chemicals, Inc. 61.76; 61.00 Eastern Salt Co. 79.50; 79.50. Tom Johnston moved to accept Morton Salt as low bid, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor. Wesley Daniel will bring the bids to the Road Crew and print off the contract to sign.

Wesley Daniel moved to sign the following appointments for the Recreations Committee; Amanda Dinsmore, Dakota Green, John Green, Angela Stevens, Travis Perez, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston is signed up for a training on Roads Software on April 13.

The Selectmen discussed what to put in the newspaper ad for Public Works Department. The salary scale and ad will be tabled until next week.

Questions and Comments

Kathleen Ocean stated there were endless questions at the town meeting about the roads, plans for the roads, construction of the roads. Also as a Budget Committee Member there were a lot of questions. She feels our Road Commissioner should have been at town meeting to answer all the questions. Mr. Hutchinson did a fantastic, articulate and knowledgeable job. The Selectmen explained Mr. Hutchinson is on the town's active Roads Committee. Discussion ensued.

Kit Lascoutx stated he and David Studer are on the ballot for the new board for Mid Coast Regional Committee.
