

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
July 27, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Albert Hutchinson, Phil Meunier, Donald Grinnell

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:07PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 07/20/16 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$3,734.10/payroll, \$125,303.28/vendor (includes school assessment), Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – Wesley Daniel reported for 7/17 – 7/23; 18th – 20th continued ditching Hopkins Road, 22nd one person took P100 to HP Fairfield to have the leaking body ram replaced. Tom Johnston moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob Temple was not present at this meeting. He left a written summary of permits given to date.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – None

Donald Grinnell, representing the Masons and EMA, explained the soon to be Reggie Upham Memorial Shelter (Town Warming Center) at the Lodge. After Reggie's passing the family requested in lieu of flowers donations be made in his name to the Mason's. During extended power outages people would be able to go get a hot cup of coffee, a cup of soup, and recharge their electrical devices. There was some discussion regarding the EMPG Grant and where the money would come from, for the project. Wesley Daniel moved to have Don Grinnell move forward with that proposal, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel proposed that any work Bob Temple has to print he can come to the office to do it or send it to the Deputy Clerk electronically to be printed. He has been reimbursed for ink that he has used. Tom Johnston moved that going forward there will be no more ink reimbursement for anyone that should be doing work here. Printing will be done at the town office, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

Questions and Comments

Tom Johnston asked if Wesley Daniel has heard from Bill Lane. Wesley called DEP - when bills come in, we forward to DEP for payment on the culvert under town letterhead.

Tom Johnston asked if there was a time frame on the Lincoln & Bump Hill Roads. Wesley Daniel stated that Hopkins Road has been ditched and ready for paving. The Bump Hill Road is ready and Lincoln Road should be done tomorrow. Wesley will call Wellman tomorrow to let them know we are all set with the roads. Wellman wants to start paving the week of August 7.

Tom Johnston asked when the new plow truck will be lettered and the radio put in. Tom will contact RCM (Radio Corporation of Maine) in Chelsea to set up an appointment. Wesley Daniel will call Jolly Signs to put the lettering on.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 7:24PM.
