

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
September 14, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Public CEO – Bob Temple
Public – None

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the summary from 09/07/16 as written, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$3,022.54/payroll, \$26,687.51 (includes plow truck payment) Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 9/4 – 9/10 5th Labor Day; 6th – 7th one of the crew took a one-day vacation, shoulder work on Hopkins Road, dust control on dirt roads. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob Temple reported that he will wait to hear from DEP regarding the Sukeforth pit to report back next week. CMP does not need a permit to replace the six poles in the Shoreland Zone. CMP will send copies of the permits required from DEP.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – None.

Wesley Daniel reported that the town received a dividend payment of \$1633.00 (\$483. Workers Comp; \$1150. Property Casualty Pool) this week which went back into the designated accounts.

Wesley Daniel reported that Dan Whittier, MMA on 8/30/16, when doing the safety survey, took pictures of the insured buildings. The premium increase of \$248.00 will be waived this year.

Wesley Daniel reported the Selectmen received a letter from Elizabeth Fish, Director of MidCoast School of Technology regarding the building project. The letter will be posted.

Questions and Comments

Wesley Daniel spoke with Tammy, Liberty's Road Commissioner, telling her Washington will plow to the end of North Palermo Road. Tammy said Liberty will clean the intersection and put bridge markers at the culvert.

Wesley Daniel broached the subject of changing the town attorney. Wesley will call Peter Drum to attend a Selectmen's Meeting for discussion.

Tom Johnston asked if the paving will be extended on Youngs Hill Road, near the culvert replacement, and what account will it come out of. Wesley Daniel said he will speak with the paver and Jonathan Daniel will mark the road and there is enough money in Capital Improvement.

Tom Johnston stated, after looking over the financial report last Friday, there are a couple of items that relate to winter maintenance and wondered when that will be started. Wesley Daniel said it should be started shortly.

Tom Johnston suggested purchasing a salt/sand shed/covering, possibly a fabric building.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 7:20PM.
