

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
January 30, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the January 23, 2102, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve payroll warrant of \$7,287.36 and an accounts payable warrant of \$10,110.42. The selectmen reviewed the TRIO GL summary looking at all unpaid taxes and liens for 20010, 2011, and 2012.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but a written report of his activities Jan 20-26. The Knox County Road Maintenance Working Group will be pursuing purchase of culverts at a consolidate bulk rate. More information will follow.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report. Bob briefed the selectmen on the following pending issues:

- 1) The Gifford property on Fitch Road has been cleaned up.
- 2) Bob is working with Dorothy Reed's son and with Andrew Thompson to bring those properties into compliance with the court order or to be cited for contempt of court.
- 3) There has been no payment of fine nor has a signed consent decree on the Fender violation on Washington Pond. Bob is working with the town attorney to get it resolved. It may end up in court.
- 4) The violation of Tim's Jackson's old junkyard is moving toward a summons to court.

The selectmen voted unanimously to appoint Sean Donaghy to fill the vacancy on the MSAD 40 school board created by the resignation of Cynthia Rosen. The appointment is until the annual town meeting when he will have to run for the position.

The selectmen voted unanimously to direct the town treasurer to place any monies received from fines, court costs, penalties, and/or reimbursement for legal fees to be placed in the legal fee line of the TRIO expense ledger.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen suspended work at 7:30 pm. They will meet individually with the auditor when her in the town office for the annual audit, Jan 31 – Feb 1.
