

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary  
October 4, 2017

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public – Brian Alves, Kit Lascoutx, Traci Hoffman

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary, with correction, from 09/27/17, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$4,867.53/payroll; \$4,032.43/vendor Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 9/24 – 9/30: 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> - shoulder work on Calderwood Road and fixed curbing; 27<sup>th</sup> shoulder work on Old Union Road - time cards attached.

CEO Report – Bob Temple gave the Selectmen a list of permits issued to date. Bob met with Peter Drum regarding all the pending issues. Peter will send the Selectmen a report and request an inspection warrant for the Condon Property. At the Planning Board's next meeting, 10/10, they will consider a non-conforming lot for a family member on Brann Road. Paul Gibbons contacted Bob to ask about processing stone work on a route 17 property. Bob will amend the Planning Board agenda to add this request. The Appeals Board has a request to do a variance on Noyes Lane. Kit Lascoutx asked Bob about Bixby on Mountain Road. Bob stated he tries to catch him home so speak with him and will continue to try. There is also a property, on Mountain Road, with 5 RV's in the dooryard. Bob will look into this with Brian Alves and Wesley Daniel. Both Kit and Traci Hoffman offered to help if they could.

Town Clerk/Treasurers Report – Ann Dean reported that Monday was tax due date; we have collected  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the 2017 taxes to date which is very impressive. Today is the day for automatic foreclosures for 2015 unpaid taxes. We have 5 land (4 of one owner; 1 small piece). Wesley Daniel moved to do the 60 days notices, per article in town warrant, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor. Ann received an email from Jay Feyler asking if someone in Washington could be appointed to the Micro Loan Program. Traci Hoffman stated she would be interested in that. Ann will get her more details and draw up the appointment paper. Denise Hylton, Sandy Patrick, and Mary Anderson are at the MMA Convention for two days. The Worker's Compensation renewal has been done and mailed in with the 1% increase for 2018.

The auto graveyard inspections were done Friday, finding everything satisfactory. Wesley Daniel moved to sign the permits, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel moved to sign the Municipal Valuation Return, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

The Selectmen have received a copy of the draft for Knox County 2018 Budget to be looked over.

The application for the Safety Enhancement Grant program for seventeen Winter Jackets has been received by MMA has been presented to the committee for review.

#### Questions and Comments

Tom Johnston asked Kit Lascoux how it is going with EMA. Kit spoke about finding an alternative way to get word out to people and to check on people (who has generators, who's on critical meds). This is information that Kit will get together. The Annual Mid Coast Regional Planning meeting is October 18<sup>th</sup>.
