

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY  
October 28, 2015

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Duane Vigue and Berkley Linscott;  
Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public: Dorothy Sainio, Henry Sainio, Cathy  
Blake

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the summary from 10/21/2015 as written, Berkley Linscott  
seconded, all in favor.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the warrants as written \$3,229.00/payroll and \$178,134.17/vendor  
(includes paving payment), Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor. Warrants read, approved,  
and signed.

Wesley Daniel reported on Public Works Report – 10/19-10/22 worked on trucks getting ready  
for winter plowing – put plows on trucks, painted plows, bed chains for standard, took P200 to  
be inspected. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Duane Vigue  
seconded, all in favor.

Bob Temple, as CEO, reported one permit issued to Medomak Camp. Bob asked the Board  
permission to contact Steinmeyer's lawyer to find out what the status is. He also has two  
outstanding gravel pits to inspect. Duane Vigue asked about a gravel pit in Somerville/  
Washington. Bob will look into this pit and report back.

Treasurer/Town Clerk – Ann Dean closed the Machias account putting \$616.41 into The First  
account. Machias donated \$100.00 each to the Washington Scholarship and Washington  
Historical Society Committees. Veteran's Day falls on Wednesday, November 11. Duane Vigue  
moved to have Wesley Daniel sign the payroll warrant and cancel the Select Board meeting on  
11/11/15 in honor of Veteran's Day, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor. Wesley Daniel and  
Ann did the road survey Monday on McDowell, Leigher, and Bump Hill Roads. Ann gave  
Jonathan Daniel a copy of the field guide for his input. She received the CD for preserved town  
records from 1933 – 1941 and will put it on the website. We are having a Rabies Clinic Saturday  
from 10-1 and will be mailing dog license reminders next week.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the new fee schedule for Inspection Fees for Mineral Extraction  
Operations (Pits that are licenses by the Mine DEP and the Bureau of Mines - \$300.00; Pits that  
are licensed by the State of Maine - \$200.00; All other active pits that are not included above  
\$100.00; Inactive Pits (pits which are not currently actively removing material - \$50.00) Wesley  
Daniel seconded, two in favor – Duane Vigue & Wesley Daniel one oppose – Berkley Linscott.

The Town Office will be closed Friday, November 13, 2015 for mandatory safety training at the Union Town Office.

The Fire Department was reimbursed \$573.33 for the safety grant.

The Board is cordially invited to a Veteran's Day Celebration at Medomak Middle School on November 10, 2015. If interested, sign up.

Wesley Daniel walked The Firs with Sean Donaghy for a plow turnaround. Sean will stake/flag area for trucks to avoid the septic tank.
