

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
November 8, 2017

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public – Traci Hoffman

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 11/01/17 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$5,601.22/payroll; \$6,696.93/vendor Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 10/29 – 11/04: 30th, 31st, 2nd, & 3rd - worked on storm damage, clearing brush and trees out of the roads and chipping; 1st – put sanders and head gear on P-100 and P-200 because they could not get a truck out of the Pit Road because of a fallen tree. Time cards attached.

CEO Report – Bob Temple reported he has not gotten a response from the letters he sent to Mr. Bixby and Mr. Leigh; the next step would be to issue a Notice of Violation. Bob will work with Peter Drum before issuing the notices. Bob asked Allen Shennett, Old County Road, to come up with a written plan, for the record, as to how he would dispose of waste water and deal with all the issues in the letter. Bob brought up the issue of the fee schedule for all projects i.e. Planning Board, Appeals Board, etc. for copies. We get reimbursed for mailings and advertising per the ordinance which Bob will put in the Findings of Fact conditions. We are generating a lot of paperwork we should come up with a fee for copies. Tom Johnston asked if we had a fee for copies; yes - .25 each 8 ½ X 11 page. Wesley Daniel said if the ordinance says to charge, we can charge the above fee. Tom asked Bob to do his copying here at the office. Tom asked how the gravel pits are coming along. Bob stated he had three more pits to inspect which will be done by tomorrow.

Town Clerk/Treasurers Report – Ann Dean gave the Selectmen an updated Expense Summary including what came out tonight. Ann sent the Budget Committee updated packets – Expense, Revenue, and General. Red Cross was not on last year's warrant, sent a letter to be on this year's. Ann will mail overdue taxes letter, next Monday, to 150 or so to town residents before the end of the year. Ann ordered a part for Jonathan Daniel for the P-300 from California (an obsolete part). There was some discussion regarding an ad for the Public Works. Ann will put the ad in the Kennebec Journal for 7 days as well as the MMA site. Tom Johnston asked Ann to contact Lynn Carroll regarding the server.

A Roads Committee Meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday, November 15 at 6pm before the Selectmen's Meeting. Berkley Linscott will contact the members.

Tom Johnston stated that Dirigo Engineering is surveying and will send the Selectmen their recommendations.

Wesley Daniel stated the School Board Meeting he attended two weeks ago went over the extra money they received. They will have meetings with the municipalities forthcoming; we will be contacted.

There was some discussion regarding purchasing a new generator for the town garage. There is nothing wrong with the one they have is too small for the compressor. Tom Johnston will contact Jim Brann to ask him what size would work best for their needs.

Wesley Daniel will contact Andy Dinsmore to call Jonathan Daniel about being an as needed plow driver. Tom Johnston will confirm with Jason Chapman. Andrea Boynton will plow on weekends.

Wesley Daniel stated that Raymond Gushee will clean up the debris in Davis Daggett Cemetery.
