

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
December 27, 2017

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public – None

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 12/20/17 as written, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$7,088.60/payroll; \$20,502.01/vendor, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Charlotte Henderson asked if the Selectmen knew of anyone that needs help during this cold weather. If they hear of anyone to contact her.

Ann Dean stated the Maine Municipal Health bill was taken off this warrant, it is due in January; she made the necessary adjustments.

Public Works Report – 12/17 – 12/23: 18th and 19th - plowed and sanded, 3 person crew; 20th - put cutting edges on P-100 & P-200 and sanded, 2 person crew; 21st – put wing on P-500, mixed sand, sanded Rt. 126, fixed door on salt shed, 2 person crew; 22nd & 23rd - plowed and sanded, 3 person crew. CEO Report – Bob Temple stated Peter Drum was out of town; has returned two violation letters and will send the rest by Friday. They will be sent out after the New Year. Wesley Daniel asked about Andrew Thompson and Brian Read's properties. Bob stated Andy is making headway and will keep in touch with him. He does not know about Brian's. Bob will check out Tim Jackson's tomorrow or Friday to find out if the cars are for resale or scrap.

Town Clerk/Treasurers Report – Ann Dean stated the town received the BETE reimbursement for 2016-2017 - \$38,170.00. Ann did the final payroll, 941, Worker's Comp, State and Federal taxes for 2017. She did corrections on the dog revenues and made accounts for the truck reserve and the fire equipment reserve. She will close 2017 on December 31.

Wesley Daniel stated they received the reimbursement check \$2,000.00 from the Safety Grants from MMA for the turnout gear.

Wesley Daniel stated the town received a letter from Central Maine Power stating that after the snow melts contractors will be cutting brush in the right of ways for the power lines. They will be using herbicides during the growing season and landowners who object to the use of herbicides can contact them. The information will be at the town office.
