

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
February 22, 2012

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the February 15, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

At 7:01 pm the selectmen voted to move to executive session under Title 1 M.R.S.A., Sec. 405, para 6 (E) to review a poverty abatement application. They returned to regular session at 7:05.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve two payroll warrants totaling \$3,361.18 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$3,268.43. After payment of the warrants there was \$106,641.59 in the checking account and \$445,775.46 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Bob Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report.

The selectmen voted unanimously to grant a poverty abatement in the amount of \$186.99 for a property on Crystal Lake Road.

The selectmen received a letter from the MSAD 40 Superintendent announcing the formation of a committee to reapportion the school board's weighted voted based on the 2010 census. This reapportionment is required by State statute. As required the selectmen voted to approve one school board representative (Guy Bourie), one selectman (Don Grinnell) and one citizen-at-large Christopher Vigue.. The committee's first meeting will be February 29th at the Superintendent Office in Union.

The selectmen received a copy of a letter from Central Maine Power Co to citizens whose property abuts the new CMP power line expansion.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:16 pm and entered into a work session to make the final review of the warrant for the 2012 annual town meeting.
