

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
September 4, 2013

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the August 28, 2013, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$3,133.84 and an accounts payable warrant of \$7,516.22.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

The selectmen voted unanimously to appoint Brian Alves as Municipal Health Officer effective immediately and until December 31st at which time he will be reappointed for three years.

Victor and Paulette Oboyski were recognized along with their attorney, Robert Marks. Mr. and Mrs. Oboyski alleged that Berkley and Nancy Linscott had violated the provisions in a May 25th letter from CEO Bob Temple to Mr. and Mrs. Linscott. The alleged violations occurred on Sunday, September 1st when Edward Blake, contractor for the Linscott's, was removing processed material from the non-permitted gravel pit on McDowell Road. The CEO was called, and he came to investigate. Additionally, the Linscott's had contacted the CEO and requested a written list of what they could or could not do regarding the gravel pit. After a long discussion among all the parties present there was still ambiguity as to what actually occurred and what was said by whom. The selectmen voted to send Mr. and Mrs. Linscott a letter stipulating what could or could not be done at the property. Don will draft the letter and have it available for the other selectmen to review on Friday morning. If all selectmen are in agreement, they will sign the letter, and it will be delivered by Don before the weekend. The general provisions of the letter are as follows and Don will phrase these and any additional points that best capture the selectmen's intent:

- 1) No more digging in the bank of the pit
- 2) No more processing of any more material
- 3) Processed material to include tailings can be removed
- 4) Establish a buffer on either side of the gate to screen the view from the road
- 5) Reslope the banks in accordance with the May 25th letter
- 6) All reclamation must be completed by October 15th.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 8:12 pm.
