

**SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY**  
**December 9, 2014**

Due to a meeting with the Knox County Legislative Delegation scheduled for Wednesday evening in Rockland, the rescheduled weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the December 3, 2014, selectmen and assessors meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$5,717.81 and an accounts payable warrant of \$9,761.95.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was present and had no written report. Bob and the selectmen discussed the following open issues:

- 1) The land use violation case against Robert Steinmeyer will be heard in Knox County District Court next Wednesday at 10:00 am. Wesley and Don will attend to represent the selectmen. The selectmen voted unanimously to request any consent agreement consist of: 1) fine of \$500 plus court cost and legal fees currently totaling \$4,495; 2) fine and fees may be paid at \$100 per month; 3) cleanup of the property not later than July 1, 2015.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve the draft warrant for the special town meeting to be held on December 30<sup>th</sup>.

With no further business to come before the board the selectmen adjourned at 7:40 pm.
