

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING**  
**February 26, 2014**

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the February 19, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$6,181.73 and an accounts payable warrant of \$119,340.05 which included the RSU 40 monthly assessment of \$109,184.84.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities February 16-22. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report. Wes reported that the estimate for damage to the overhead door caused by a municipal truck at the town garage was \$2250. A claim has been submitted to MMA insurance. There is \$1000 deductible on the claim.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement officer, was present. Bob, Wes, and Duane had attended District Court for land use violations and provided the results from the Court;

- 1) The case against George Hall & Sons was settled during a conference. The Town agreed to accept one-half of the court costs and legal fees and to lift the Stop Work Order. George Hall & Sons agreed to pay one-half the court costs and legal fees and to sign a consent agreement (to be drafted by the town attorney) outlining the steps the company must follow in the future to comply with the annual inspection requirements of the mining ordinance.
- 2) The Hoffman case will be going to a judicial hearing. The date is unknown at the time.
- 3) The Linscott case is being moved to Superior Court at the request of Mr. and Mrs. Linscott. The date is unknown at this time.
- 4) The Doug Daniel case was resolved by payment of the inspection fee and all court costs and legal fees to the town attorney prior to the court date. The case was then dismissed.

The selectmen voted to accept a 2014 Maine Emergency Management Agency grant in the amount of \$1,750 for upgrades to the town emergency operations center.

With nothing additional to come before the Board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:32 pm.
