

## **SELECTMEN'S MEETING**

**April 23, 2014**

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the April 16, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved with one correction.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3,229.14 and an accounts payable warrant of \$114,273.33 which included the monthly RSU assessment of \$109,184.84.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities April 13-19. The selectmen voted unanimously to approve the report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement officer, was absent as he was attending a Midcoast Regional Planning Commission Meeting.

Peg Hobbs and the selectmen discussed the new recreation field approved by voters at town meeting. September 27<sup>th</sup> is the target date for completion with an open house/play day scheduled. The area needs to be leveled, loamed and seeded. A fence needs to be erected to separate the play area from the fire pond.

After discussion the selectmen voted unanimously to purchase a wood chipper for the road maintenance department. All the tree and brush damage caused by the December ice storm needs to be chipped. Renting a chipper will cost \$3000 for the estimated three weeks required clean up time. The selectmen decided to purchase a new 6 inch self-feed chipper with a 24 hp Honda engine for \$10,199. The funds will come from existing accounts.

With nothing additional to come before the Board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:34 pm.
