Road Foreman Report:

Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel: 1/6/2019: 12am-1:30am Sanded roads; 1/7/2019: We sanded dirt roads and looked over trucks. Called HP Fairfield about wing post for P300 (\$290.00) it will take three weeks. Donald Bowman will try to do it on Monday; 1/8/2019: 4am-7pm We plowed and sanded. Kevin and Greg showed Steven their routes so he will be familiar with them; 1/9/2019: 6am-12am Three of us sanded dirt roads, called Steven in at 2:30pm to help plow. P400 broke down at 11pm, Kevin and I towed it back to the shop; 1/10/2019: 12am-6am Back at 9:30am to plow slush; 1/11/2019: Kevin and Frank took a holiday. Timecards attached. Frank Jones, Jr also stated that the P400 has 3 bad injectors and it was agreed upon to replace all of the injectors while the engine is apart.

CEO Report:

Bob Temple stated that the date for the upcoming inspection for the property near Crystal Lake that is out of compliance is still to be determined. He is working on Rhea's subdivision with the Planning Board. He did a commercial kitchen inspection. Mining fee collections are still ongoing. Bob would like the mining operations that were Grandfathered in by the state to be required to submit a new plan describing their operation including a plan for reclamation.

Other Agenda Items:

Discuss Village Area Sign: It has been suggested that a blinking light on Rt. 220 Southbound across from Sweet Season would be helpful in slowing down traffic entering the village area. It was agreed upon by the Selectmen to add it as a separate article to be voted on as a one-time expense at the Town Meeting in March.

Peg Hobbs Recreation Committee: Peg Hobbs stated that the Somerville School has an indoor walking club that they are trying to promote but the Recreation Committee has decided not to run a program there because of the potential liability and the conflict with the current walking group that meets on the same day but at an earlier time. They will post it on their Facebook page to help get the word out. Peg also stated that they have run background checks on the new coaches.

Central Maine Power Tree Work: CMPCO sent a notification that they will be clearing brush and trimming trees along the transmission rights-of-way. They will be selectively using herbicide during the growing season. If any homeowners object to the use of the herbicide, they should contact CMP directly. The full notification is posted at the Town Office.
