

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
March 07, 2018

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public – Kit Lascoux, Traci Hoffman, Sean Donaghy

Wesley Daniel called the weekly Selectmen Meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 02/28/18 with corrections, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$5,396.51/payroll; \$17,872.98/vendor Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 2/25 – 3/3: 25th – plowed and sanded; 26th – got the backhoe ready to fix mud holes, took wing off P-500, washed trucks; 27th – worked on Old County Road mud hole and swamp area; 28th - worked on Old County Road in swamp area; 1st - finished work on Old County Road, worked on Dorman Road, posted roads; 2nd – checked roads for ice. CEO Report – Bob Temple stated he met with Peter Drum who approved the final version of the Consent Agreement for David Bixby. Mr. Bixby will come to the town office to sign, have it notarized, then the Selectmen will sign. Bob has spoken with Daryl Flagg regarding his mining fee. Daryl wants to do excavation up to a 100 feet of Muddy Pond (old pit previously owned by David Sinclair). Bob looked at the approval which states no activity within 250 feet of the pond. Bob received an Intent to Harvest from the Forestry Service for Daryl Flagg to clear cut 20 acres, expanding the gravel pit. The pit is approved for 3 acres. Peter Drum and Bob will draft a letter to Daryl Flagg to explain expanding the pit and what needs to be done if that is his intent as well as what the consequence is if the inspection fee is not paid. Wesley Daniel stated he received a call from a resident on Bill Luce Road who said he will clean up his yard. Bob will speak to him about the tires that need to be removed from the property. Bob will also speak with Tim Jackson regarding tires in the yard that need to be put in the container.

Town Clerk/Treasurers Report – Ann Dean stated on Monday she mailed 135 certified 30-day notices. The town reports were picked up yesterday; Ann delivered them to Jackson's, Post Office, Washington Auto, Washington General and brought one to Dorothy Sainio. Berkley Linscott will take his town reports tonight. Ann stated Deputy II Clerk, Sandra Patrick, has been here for eight months and she is not up to the regular Deputy Clerk pay. Wesley Daniel stated it will be done the first of May. Marcus Ballou, MMA, met with Ann and the Selectmen about all the insurances and Risk Pool.

Wesley Daniel reminded the Select Board about the three scheduled School Board Budget Meetings. Wesley will attend next Monday's meeting. Ann Dean will print an email regarding the meeting where they will discuss why the budget has gone up so much.

The Selectmen signed the renewal license for Washington General to serve beer and wine with a meal.

The Selectmen received one proposal to install a propane tank at the town garage. Tom Johnston will check on other possible proposals.

Wesley Daniel stated the Board will meeting with Mike Mayo, potential moderator for town meeting, on March 21 at 6PM to discuss the upcoming warrant for town meeting.
