

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
April 12, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel and Berkley Linscott; Town Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public: Kit Lascoux, Dave Williams

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the summary from 04/06/16 as written, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

Berkley Linscott moved to accept the warrants as written \$4,121.20/payroll and \$2,612.92/vendor Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – Wesley Daniel reported for 04/03-04/09 – 3rd-checked the roads for ice, 4th & 5th worked in the garage, 6th & 7th plowed, sanded, cleaned trucks and cleaned up downed trees on Bill Luce and Calderwood Road. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the report as read, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – None.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – Ann Dean reported that Tom Johnston mailed out the fire truck bid packages last Thursday. Tom also called, regarding the town office, the company Reggie Burns worked with to put the sign on the fire station. Bill Stewart from Kofile picked up the 1942-1960 records book for preservation; the cost is \$4,237.00. Ann called Electricity Maine to have the kilowatt rates changed – the bills had different suppliers charging different amounts. She opted for the cheaper rate with a one-year contract. The CMP bills should be checked carefully. Ann asked Wesley Daniel to sign the user agreement for the accessible voting system that she will pick up at the training in Waldoboro on April 29.
