

Selectmen/Assessor's Meeting Summary
August 31, 2016

In attendance: Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott; Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; Public CEO – Bob Temple Public – Henry Sainio, Dorothy Sainio, Charlotte Henderson, Jane Carroll, Lynn Carroll, Debbie Bocko

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Tom Johnston moved to accept the summary from 08/24/16 Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to pay the warrants as presented \$4,186.14/payroll, \$126,894.99 /vendor (includes August school payment) Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Public Works Report – 08/21 – 08/27 21st – 24th marked Old County Road for culvert replacement, continued doing shoulder work on Hopkins Road, repaired intersection of Dorman and McDowell Roads after the fire at the camp, took the culverts to Old County Road for replacement. Berkley Linscott moved to accept the Public Works Report as read, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

CEO Report – Bob Temple presented his permit summary to date. He is working on a couple of camps on Steele Lane looking to expand. He has not caught up with Sukeforth to hand deliver the letter and Stop Work Order.

Town Clerk/Treasurer Report – Ann Dean reported the bank balance to be \$141,294.19 (warrant this week 126,894.00). Today Ann sent out 37 certified letters for 23 auto foreclosures. There was two five week months that the road crew overpaid in health insurance. They were reimbursed this week through the vendor warrant. Charlotte Henderson had sent an email to Ann with the contact numbers for the Game Warden regarding the 'truck in the lake'. Ann forwarded the email to the Selectmen. Wesley Daniel copied it and gave it to Berkley Linscott.

The Selectmen signed the Auto Graveyard letters to be sent out with the application for automobile graveyard/junkyard permit

Wesley Daniel moved to sign the Warrant & Notice of Election Calling Region of Mid-Coast School of Technology Referendum, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Tom Johnston moved to sign the revised policy for Treasurer's Disbursement Warrants for Employee Wages, Benefits and State Fees, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

David Martucci sent a note, to the Selectmen, to be considered for the Town Government Review Committee. Wesley Daniel moved to sign the appointment paper for David Martucci to be on the Town Government Review Committee, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel had information regarding the Mid Coast Regional Planning Commission Fall Commission meeting on 10/20/16 6PM – 8:30PM if anyone is interested in attending. Ann Dean will contact Kit Lascoux to ask him if he'd like to attend.

Wesley Daniel would like to put a bid notice for 2017, 2018, & 2019, in the newspaper, to have the figures for the next town meeting for roadside mowing, mowing of the town grounds, and cemetery maintenance.

Questions and Comments

Wesley Daniel stated there was a meeting with the county last night regarding the towns to pool together for a county wide Animal Control Officer. They will draw up a contract with the cost. Ann Dean will send them information that was requested. There will be more meetings in the future.

Wesley Daniel was notified today that Youngs Hill Road culvert will be started on 9/7 for up to 21 days. Wesley called the Fire Chief and will contact the school and post office tomorrow.

Jonathan Daniel will turn the plow truck around at the end of the road in Liberty.

Wesley Daniel had an email from Jolly Signs with a picture of the sign for Davis Daggett Cemetery, double sided 22 X 36, ready to hang for \$280.00. Wesley Daniel moved to call Jolly Signs to make the sign, Tom Johnston seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel reported that the MMA Safety Survey was done the other day going through all the buildings. A report will be sent.

Dorothy Sainio asked if the cemetery maintenance can be done for three years or does it have to be bought up in town meeting. Wesley Daniel and Tom Johnston said it was fine.

Deb Bocko asked if there was a sign the town could put up off Route 220 onto McDowell Road just before her house. She has put a couple of signs up but it doesn't seem to slow the traffic. Wesley Daniel said it's up to the land owner to put signs up.

Charlotte Henderson said she would like assurance that the information will be presented to the Warden Service regarding the 'truck in the lake'. Wesley Daniel said it will be done.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 7:35PM.
