

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY**  
**January 23, 2013**

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue also present.

The summary of the January 16, 2102, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve payroll warrant of \$4,375.57 and an accounts payable warrant of \$14,548.67. As of January 23<sup>rd</sup> there was \$99,987.46 in the operating account and \$665,350.59 in the interest bearing sweep account.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent but a written report of his activities Jan 13 – 19. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report. Next week the road crew will report to Health Connections in Rockport for their initial drug screening as required by Federal law. After initial screening they will be subject to random screening per the program conducted by Health Connections. On days with little snow work or truck maintenance the road crew will cut and remark the lines around the town pit property designated in the survey conducted in 2011.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report. Bob has determined that Tim Jackson is in violation. He will be working with the town attorney to take the case to court.

The selectmen approved a template for Dorothy Reed and Andrew Thompson to pay their land use violation fines in an installment plan. The first payments will be due February 20<sup>th</sup>.

The selectmen signed a letter to Gary Smith, d.b.a. Washington Trust, and returned the checks that had been received for back taxes, interest and fees for property on Washington Pond that the town had foreclosed. The checks did not cover the total amount previously owed and were received after the 60-day period in which a previous owner may buy the property back from the town.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen suspended work at 7:34 pm. They then met with Ann in a work session to continue work on the proposed 2013 municipal budget. They adjourned from the work session at 8:35 pm and returned to regular session. They then voted unanimously to approve the draft budget. It will be distributed to the budget committee a few days before budget meeting.
