

SELECTMEN and ASSESSORS MEETING SUMMARY  
November 4, 2015

*In attendance:* Select Board – Wesley Daniel, Duane Vigue and Berkley Linscott;  
Clerk/Treasurer – Ann Dean; CEO – Bob Temple; Public: Dorothy Sainio, Henry Sainio, Cathy  
Blake

Wesley Daniel called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the summary from 10/28/2015 as written, Berkley Linscott  
seconded, all in favor.

Duane Vigue moved to accept the warrants as written \$5,808.04/payroll (includes Fire Fighters  
Stipends) and \$14,861.03/vendor (includes Social Services), Berkley Linscott seconded, all in  
favor. Warrants read, approved, and signed.

Wesley Daniel reported on Public Works Report – 10/26-10/29 worked on P400 plow, fluid film  
on P300, installed sander on P200, checked roads for debris after storm on Wednesday night,  
marked Mountain Road for culvert replacement. Duane Vigue moved to accept the Public Works  
Report as read, Berkley Linscott seconded, all in favor.

Bob Temple, as CEO, reported one building permit issued to Pierpont. He's still working on the  
gravel pit in question from last week's meeting. Bob asked if the Mining Ordinance should get  
together to go over the ordinance. The mining inspection fees approved at last week's meeting  
will become effective January 1, 2016.

Treasurer/Town Clerk – Ann Dean reported that HP Fairfield called to report the new plow truck  
will be started on November 19 and be ready by the middle of December. The P100 will be sold  
when the new truck is received. A rabies clinic was held this past Saturday (23 dogs & 2 cats, 20  
from town). Voting went well; 276 voters – (question 1-133 yes, 141 no, 2 blank; question 2-  
184 yes, 91 no, 1 blank; question 3-191 yes, 85 no).

Wesley Daniel read Duane Vigue's resignation letter. He will work as Selectman until the  
March 2016 Town Meeting. Duane has one year left to his term which will need to be filled.  
Berkley Linscott moved to accept Duane Vigue's resignation letter for Selectman effective  
March 2016 Town Meeting, Wesley Daniel seconded, all in favor.

Wesley Daniel will have Phil Meunier look at the benches in the Village Park. The wood is  
deteriorating and they need to be fixed.

There was discussion regarding portions of the budget. Ann Dean would like to increase the  
Deputy Clerk monies so Denise Hylton will be able fill in as needed.

Mary Anderson will check with Bob Temple regarding publishing for Appeals Board whether to charge the applicant or not.

Duane Vigue stated they are all set at the garage for Safety Works. Jodi was tested for the respirator.

Wesley Daniel tested the emergency lights in the library and town office. Wes called Jim Brann to replace the two light bulbs out in the library.

Wesley Daniel adjourned the meeting at 8:00PM.
