

SELECTMANS SUMMARY

NOVEMBER 28, 2012

THE WEEKLY Selectman's Meeting was brought to order at 6:00 p.m. by Selectman Wes Daniel with Selectman Duane Vigue present and Selectman Don Grinnell absent.

There was no weekly summary presented for the week of November 21, 2012. That summary will be presented on Dec. 6th along with the summary from Nov. 28, 2012.

There was a Payroll Warrant of \$5279.25 and two Vendor Warrants, one for \$938.00 and another for \$3097.91. All three warrants were approved as written.

Road Commissioner John Daniel was absent but provided a written report. The report was approved as written.

CEO Bob Temple was present but had no written report. He did explain that he was present at the court hearing on Monday along with Selectman Wes Daniel pertaining to several citizens that were in violation of the land use ordinance. The court found in the towns favor and the concerned citizens were ordered to pay a fine of \$500.00 plus court costs for non-compliance. They were also ordered to come into compliance with the land use ordinance pertaining to the collection of debris and junk in their yards. A contempt of court order will be issued if they do not comply.

We will be arranging a Roads Committee meeting in the near future at the Bryant Room located at the Gibbs Library to discuss the town paving program for the upcoming year.

With no further business to come before the board the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m. to ready for the Special Town Meeting pertaining to the McDowell Rd. NO THRU TRUCKS hearing.
