

SELECTMAN'S MEETING SUMMARY

NOVEMBER 6TH, 2013

The weekly selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by selectman Wes Daniel with selectman Duane Vigue present and selectman Don Grinnell absent.

There was no October 30th summary available for review. The selectman will review this summary on Nov. 13th.

The selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$3309.38 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$6140.02.

Jon Daniel was not present but provided a written report of the Road Crew activities for the period from Oct. 27th to Nov. 2nd 2013

CEO Robert Temple was present and presented an update concerning the issue with the Linscott gravel pit located on the McDowell Rd.. Mr. Temple has met with the Linscott's Attorney and is awaiting a draft of a consent agreement from her. Mr. Temple will review the consent agreement and present it to the board of selectman.

Mitch Garnett was present representing the Planning Board. He discussed the issue of a secretary to take minutes of the Planning Board Meetings. With the recent Resignation of Mrs. Leeann Chapman the position is still in need of resolution.

The Board of Selectman received a letter from the town auditor William Brewer outlining the process and reviews that will take place for our fiscal year ending Dec. 31st 2013.

The Board of Selectman received a letter from Midcoast Regional Planning asking for our membership. Duane is reviewing the letter and the services that Midcoast Regional Planning offer.

The trees at the McDowell Cemetery that were commissioned to be taken down have been removed. Due to rot and decay they were presenting an extreme danger to the public. They were quite grand and will be sadly missed.
