The Selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$10,548.79 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$14,473.16

The Selectman signed a new petty cash policy. The petty cash account was created in an amount not to exceed \$50.00. The monies will be used for the purchase of postal money orders needed for town business.
