

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
May 7, 2013

The re-scheduled weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel with Selectmen Donald Grinnell also present. Selectman Duane Vigue was absent.

The summary of the May 1, 2013, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant of \$5,844.45 and two accounts payable warrants of \$1,133.41 and \$27,378.24, which included the final payment on the lease to own plow truck. They reviewed the expense report dated May 1.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer, was absent and had no written report.

The town has received notification it had been approved for FEMA reimbursement for Blizzard '13 as part of a Presidential Disaster Declaration. The town was approved for reimbursement totaling \$14,645.15 with \$12,204 federal funds (75% of the total) due to arrive soon and \$2,440 State Funds (15%) due to arrive when the State has the money. The remaining 10% is the local share.

The town has received a 1,000 page document from Central Maine Power Co. that show minor revisions to the Reliability Program under which CMP is rebuilding the power line in the northwest corner of town.

The town received a letter from Senator Chris Johnson explaining the potential for elimination or decrease in Revenue Sharing being considered in the Legislature.

The selectmen voted unanimously to appoint Tom Potter as Alternate member to the Board of Appeals.

Don reported that the memorial Day flags have been ordered.

With no further business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:16 pm.
