

SELECTMEN'S MEETING SUMMARY
May 9, 2012

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectmen Donald Grinnell and Duane Vigue were also present.

The summary of the May 2, 2012, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant totaling \$2,919.94 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$4,890.86 leaving a balance of \$100,000 in the operating account and \$203,231.03 in the interest bearing sweep account. The selectmen reviewed the TRIO expense report dated May 9th.

Frank Jones, Jr., Road Commissioner, was absent but provided a written report of his activities April 26 – May 9. The selectmen voted unanimously to accept his report. Frank and his crew have begun ditching on the Mountain Road using capital improvement funds.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement Officer was present but had no written report. Bob had provided a proposed draft of a fee schedule for consideration. The selectmen voted to postpone discussion so that it can be compared with other ordinances to insure completeness.

Wes announced that Clayton Lamphier will resign as Animal Control Officer effective at the end of the month.

Wes stated that the new ordinances books need to be published, but Don reminded him that the latest amendments adopted at town meeting need to be incorporated into the written ordinances first.

The selectmen signed six Requests for Proposals to be mailed to engineering firms for the design and engineering on two culvert replacement projects.

With no additional business to come before the board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:15 pm.
