

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
February 19, 2014

The weekly selectmen's meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Selectman Wesley Daniel. Selectman Donald Grinnell and Selectman Duane Vigue were also in attendance.

The summary of the February 12, 2014, selectmen's meeting was approved as written.

The selectmen voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$5,594.99 and an accounts payable warrant of \$6,972.23.

Jonathan Daniel, Road Commissioner, was absent and had no written report.

Robert Temple, Code Enforcement officer, was present and briefed the selectmen on the following on-going issues:

- 1) The case against Robert Steinmeyer for a land use violation to be heard February 19th at Knox County District Court was postponed by the Court due to inclement weather. No rescheduled date has been chosen.
- 2) Bob reported that he has been contacted by the attorney for Berkley and Nancy Linscott that Mr. and Mrs. Linscott are requesting to have their court appearance moved to Superior Court with a trial by jury.

Chief Tom Johnston has spent many hours troubleshooting and trying to repair the air compressor at the firehouse. Eventually a new compressor was purchased by the fire department and installed by Tom. The selectmen voted unanimously to give the old inoperable compressor to Tom.

The selectmen are seeking two volunteers to represent the town on the Midcoast Regional Planning Commission.

The selectmen signed a contract with the Maine State Police to take over responsibility for concealed weapons permit application processing and approval. Further information will be made as soon as details of the new procedures are determined.

The annual town financial audit has been completed by William Brewer, CPA. A copy of the audit report may be reviewed at the town office during normal business hours. It will also be part of the annual town report.

Wes has filed a claims report for damage to one of the town garage doors caused by an plow truck minor accident.

After a final review of the draft municipal warrant by the selectmen and town clerk, the selectmen signed the 2014 warrant for the annual town meeting.

With nothing additional to come before the Board, the selectmen adjourned at 7:45 pm.
