

SELECTMAN'S AND ASSESSOR'S MEETING

July 9, 2014

The weekly selectman's meeting was called to order at 7:00 by Selectman Wes Daniel. Selectman Duane Vigue was in attendance with selectman Don Grinnell absent.

No summary of was provided for the July 2, 2014 Selectman's meeting.

The Selectman voted unanimously to approve a payroll warrant in the amount of \$4062.78 and a vendor warrant in the amount of \$ 18,871.72

John Daniel, Road Commissioner provided a written report of activities from June 29th- July 5th. The selectman voted unanimously to accept his report.

Bob Temple, CEO was present and stated that he had contacted the State Forest Service concerning some timber harvesting issues in town. The Forest Service has stated that they will handle the towns concerns. They have also requested that the town grant them jurisdiction to handle all timber harvesting concerns. This will need to be done by ordinance change. Bob will investigate the proper ordinances that need to be addressed.

The Hoffman land use violation court case is scheduled for Wed. August 27th 2014.

Leticia VanVuuren presented the new flood plain maps to the Select Board for review. After reviewing the Town of Washington's maps it was decided that they were quite accurate for our area.
