Review of application for Wireless Telecommunication Facility on Liberty Road: a) determine the application is complete; b) schedule a public hearing; c) set up a balloon test.

Jackie Murray handed out copies, to each board member, of a packet with all the information to go through which included a letter of authorization from Tom and Deb Johnston allowing them to move forward, application forms, a letter to comply with Article 11 of the Telecom Ordinance and the check list, with supporting documents.

After discussion James Bowers made a motion to accept the application as complete, Dave Studer seconded, all in favor.

The balloon test, requested in the Town of Washington Ordinance will show 'unreasonable visual impact'. The test is schedule for July 27, rain date July 28, 2015, 7am-12noon. The Board Members suggested places they should take pictures from. The public notice will state that if anyone has any concerns, please contact Bob Temple.

The Public Hearing notice will be published in the newspaper, posted around town, and sent to the abutters.

The Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 in the Bryant Room at Gibbs Library. The Board may begin deliberation, on the project, at the close of the public hearing.
