Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

8/10/2020: 6:00am-4:30pm – Ditched on Bowman Mills; Started to spread gravel; Greg left at 2:30 Dr. App

8/11/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Helped dig for phone line on Fitch Road in the morning; Worked on cleaning the garage; Called out for a tree on Mountain Road

8/12/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Spread gravel on Bowman Mills Road; Checked in at Fitch Road; Worked on P-400 lights; Called out for tree on Bill Luce Road

8/13/2020: 6:30am-5:00pm – New truck is at H.P. Fairfield; I called Nate for Maple Grove Cemetery; Greg and I removed the dugouts from the school; Unplugged the culvert on Vanner Road; Moved stuff outside of the garage

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he has had requests for property owners wanting to expand cottages on Billings Lane; The Shoreland Zoning, DEP and the Forestry Service are all going out to the property on Prescott Road that was cleared to evaluate the situation, Wes and Berkley are going to go also. David and Zelma Williams stated that they are very concerned with the state of the property on Prescott Road that was cleared; They stated that without the trees that property will erode causing run-off and the remaining trees could uproot and end up in the Pond.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the loans for the plow and fire trucks have been signed; Stephanie is updating the website; Joan is working on processing Absentee Ballot Requests; Mary is working on the Town Meeting Summary.

Other Agenda Items:

The agreement for Union Ambulance was submitted for the Selectmen signatures; Tom Johnston voiced some concerns over the language in the agreement; After some discussion, Tom Johnston made a motion to sign the agreement with reservations, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in favor, Motions passed.

Questions and Comments:

David and Zelma Williams stated that they have seen kids on the island in Washington Pond lighting fires and were wondering what they should do. They voiced concerns that if a spark flies and since it has been so dry, it could cause a fire on the island and/or around the pond; Tom Johnston stated that next time they see any fires, they should call the Sherriff's Dept or Forestry; In the meantime, Tom stated that he would post some "no fires" signs around the island.

Wesley Daniel made a motion to go into executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405(6)(A) to discuss a personnel matter, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's passed.

Wesley Daniel made a motion to return to regular session, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's passed.

Wesley Daniel asked if there was any other business. There was no response.

Motion to Adjourn by Berkley Linscott, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.
