



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

August 5, 2020

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of July 29, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

7/27/2020: 6:30am-5:30pm - Greg and I started to ditch and fixed washout on Bowman Mill Rd; Looked at the dugouts at the ball field; Met with Matt Green to look at the tree at Maple Grove Cemetery.

7/28/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm - We replaced a culvert 12x20 on Bowman Mill Road and ditched, I hit a phone line that was not marked.

7/29/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm - We ditched on Bowman Mill Road.

7/30/2020: 6:30am-5:30pm - We ditched and opened up culvert on Vanner Road, it is plugged by the beaver; Chris Packard helped with the excavator 3:30pm-5:30pm.

8/01/2020: 11:30am-12:30pm - I met with Nate Benner at Maple Grove Cemetery to look at the tree.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he went over to the garage on Rt 17 that is a marijuana grow facility and he stated that it is for medical marijuana and he requested a detailed description of the activities that are happening there; Bob received the application from Welch Engineering for a solar array and there was a lot of vital information that was missing and Bob will go meet with them next week to go over it with them; Bob stated that the other party that is interested in putting up a solar array has a new representative so the process is slow going; Tom Johnston asked how the pit inspections are going and Bob stated that he is about 1/3 done and is hoping to be done before the end of August.

Health Officer Report: Not present.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the tax bills went out yesterday (8/4/20); the bank balance is \$176,231.18; the three loans will close on Thursday August 13 at 11:00am; The Machias loan will be paid off August 14: \$37,008.23; Joan is training on Accounts Payable and Payroll; Kevin from Transco is going to come in to talk about the copier.

Other Agenda Items:

The Selectmen signed the May bank reconciliation.

Fee Schedule update: Wesley Daniel made a suggestion with Mary's input that there could be an additional fee to the applicant for Bob Temple's excessive time spent working on a permit or project. Tom Johnston commented that the fee schedule should be codified. Mary Anderson stated that the fees collected would go into the appropriate corresponding accounts. Wesley Daniel stated that there is a \$250 after the fact fee that should be assessed for projects that have gone ahead without a permit. After further discussion, it was decided to table the fee schedule discussion until a future meeting.

Hagar called Frank Jones Jr. to ask about paving. Wesley Daniel made a motion to postpone paving until next year, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion's passed.

Plowing the Town Grounds for the 20/21 season: Wes is going to talk to Frank Jones Jr. about what should be put in the notice as far as which areas are to be plowed.

Dugouts: Peg would like the screen removed to be put on the new dugouts; the old dugouts will be given to someone who is willing to haul them away.

Fitch Road bridge: The flatbed broke down and they should start tomorrow. CMP is all set but no communications from Consolidated as of yet.
