



**Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary  
June 24, 2020  
7:00 P.M.**

**Selectmen Present:** Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott,

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Approve Summary of June 17, 2020:** Motion to approve summary by Berkley Linscott, Tom Johnston 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's carried.

**Sign Treasurer's Warrant dated June 24, 2020:**

Motion to pay warrants by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's carried.

**Road Foreman Report:** Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

6/1/2020: 6:00-5:00 I picked up excavator; Kevin and Greg cut up downed tree at boat landing; replaced and 18"x60' culvert on Youngs Hill Road.

6/2/2020: 6:30-4:30 Ditched and replaced 2 culverts- 15x40 12x20

6/3/2020: 6:30-4:30 Greg left at 3pm; ditched and removed big stump.

6/4/2020: 6:30-4:30 Greg took the day off as vacation day; Kevin and I replaced 15x40 road culvert and ditched.

**CEO Report:** Bob Temple stated that he is continuing with the pit inspections, he is working with Mitch to get the Planning Board meetings going.

**Health Officer Report:** Not present.

**Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report:** Mary Anderson stated that we received a revenue share check for \$8,635.36; She has the Safety Policies for 2nd tier ready to be signed; We received a check for \$100 for reimbursement for court fees from a Dog Summons; The bank balance is \$112,131.63.

**Other Agenda Items:**

Tom Johnston opened the paving bids;

Pike Industries- \$70.69 for shim and finish

Wellman Paving- \$71.75 for shim and finish

Hagar Industries- \$66.00 for shim and \$64.00 finish

All States Asphalt- \$82.50 shim mix & OR D MIX, \$81.50 OR C MIX, \$80.50 OR B MIX

The Selectmen agreed to accept Hagar Industries bid and Tom Johnston suggested tabling the paving until after the Town meeting. Wesley Daniel concurred.

-The Town Meeting date is suggested for July 18<sup>th</sup>, at 10:00am at the Fire Station. Tom Johnston is going to talk to Matt about a sound system; Mary suggested that the Selectmen wear masks when not speaking to set an example.

-There is a proposal for the Town Meeting to begin July 14<sup>th</sup>, 8:00am to be adjourned at 8:00pm until July 18<sup>th</sup> 10:00am. Tom Johnston made a motion to accept the Town Meeting dates as presented, Wesley Daniel 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's carried.

-Wesley Daniel presented the School Budget Warrant to be signed; Tom Johnston made a motion to sign the Warrant as presented, Berkley Linscott 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's carried.

-Wesley Daniel stated that he has a request for a CMP pole permit for Blair Road. It was determined that it will be given to Frank Jones Jr, the Road Foreman to check out and it will be brought up again next week.

-Wesley Daniel made a motion to sign the Office Safety Policies; Tom Johnston 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's Carried.

#### **Questions and Comments:**

James Kearney stated that he is very concerned with the erosion that is occurring on Calderwood Road near his house. He believes that the side of the road that was previously ditched has not been properly stabilized and is eroding into the Little Medomak. He suggested that Frank Jones Jr. take a class in 9-point soil erosion prevention. Wesley Daniel stated that he and Bob Temple, the Code Enforcement Officer, have an appointment to inspect Washington Town Pit next Tuesday and that they would go look at the location then and get back to him in regards to a resolution.

-Tom Johnston stated that he is expecting the contract from Dirigo for the Fitch Road bridge this week.
