Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

5/25/2020: 6:30-4:30 Memorial Day- Holiday

5/26/2020: 6:30-4:30 Kevin on vacation; Greg and I tried to fix oil leaks on back hoe; Replaced some hoses and washed it; Picked up P-400.

5/27/2020: 6:30-4:30 Greg and I took down fences at fire pond-2 hours; Ditched on Med-o-Lark Road.

5/28/2020: 6:30-4:30 Greg and I ditched on Med-o-Lark Road; Hay and seeded ditch; I called FC Works, they get \$2.64 a yard for screening; Called Dave Petee about paving.

CEO Report: Bob Temple was not present.

No Health Officer Report: Brian Alves stated that the Food Pantry is well stocked at this time and everything is going well at the present time.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the bank balance was \$114,279.79; The office opened on Monday, we are sanitizing in-between customers; Kate DuFour wanted feedback about Covid-19; We asked Prescott if we could use the school for the Town Meeting on July 18th and they said no because the gym floor is being refinished during that time, we asked Medomak if we could use the camp for the meeting and we are waiting to hear back. Tom Johnston suggested that we use the Fire House and Mary replied that is a possibility that we are considering; At this time, the Town Meeting is tentatively scheduled for July 18th.

Other Agenda Items:

-Peg Hobbs from the Recreation Committee: Peg Hobbs stated that the Rec Committee canceled the Kayak/Canoe Race and the 5K this summer; She asked the Selectmen if they would still like to get a porta-potty for the public boat launch at Washington Pond; The Lakes Association has budgeted for July and August. The Selectmen agreed that a porta-potty would be beneficial; Chris Packard's estimate was accepted; The Monday morning walkers are going to resume and will be practicing social distancing; The signs for 3' clearance for vehicles when passing pedestrians and bikes on Bill Luce and McDowell roads were put up; One of the dugouts has fallen over; Evan from Waldoboro called about using Prescott field for baseball and it will not be able to be used; they will most likely use Jackson's field and the Washington children will be able to participate.

-Wesley Daniel presented an on-premise liquor license for Blueberry Fields. It is the same as last year. Wesley made a motion to sign the application, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

-The Selectmen and the Town Clerk discussed changes to the Warrant for the Town Meeting.

-Tom Johnston made a motion to accept the budget with the exception of the Rec Committee which will be returned to \$2,000, Wesley Daniel 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

-Signed notice of award to Timberland to build Fitch Road Bridge.
