Wesley Daniel Called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

10/07/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Serviced P-200 at hour 9881; started to work on P-300 headgear.

10/08/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Put 588 yards of winter sand & 35 yards salt.

10/09/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Fixed wash out on Prescott Road going down the big hill and it will need a new culvert.

10/10/19 6:00am-4:30pm: Put up 350 yards of winter sand and 14 yards salt; worked on P-300 headgear; Called out for down tree on West Washington Road, no tree to be found.

Tom Johnston asked Frank if the cutting edges and chains have been ordered for the winter. Frank responded that they have been but the cost has gone up due to the tariffs. Wesley Daniel asked if there were any questions regarding the Road Foremen's Report and there were not.

CEO Report: Bob Temple gave the Selectmen a copy of the junkyard inspection reports. Wesley Daniel stated that they were going to be discussed further on in the meeting. He also stated that he has been doing plumbing and building inspections.

We will be upgrading to Windows 10 in about three weeks. The bank balance is \$981,817.07. Dog licenses for 2020 have been available since October 15.

The Selectmen signed the Junkyard Permits. All were approved with the exception of Tim Jackson. Tim Jackson's permit was signed with a list of conditions that will need to be adhered to or his permit will be pulled. Bob is going to speak to Peter regarding drawing up a consent decree.
