



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

September 9, 2020

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of September 2, 2020: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Berkley Linscott 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Sign Treasurer's Warrant dated September 9, 2020:

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

8/31/2020: 6:00am-4:30pm – Greg and I put up 52 loads of winter sand, 364 yards and 21 yards of salt; I looked at the bridge on Fitch Road, I did not like the approach. Wesley Daniel stated that the approach was fixed.

9/01/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Put up 63 loads of winter sand, 441 yards and 21 yards of salt.

9/02/2020: 6:30am-4:30pm – Put up 70 loads of winter sand, 490 yards and 28 yards of salt.

9/03/2020: 6:30am-4:00pm – Put up 61 loads of winter sand, 427 yards and 28 yards of salt.

CEO Report: Bob Temple stated that he has 1/3 of the mining permits done; He completed the Finding of Fact for the Solar Array and he will get drafts to the Planning Board; He received a compliant from the Mendelson's on Noyes Lane regarding a shed that is too close to their property line and he is going to look into it; He should be 50% complete with the pit inspections by next week; Wesley Daniel asked about the Prescott Road situation and Bob replied that he hasn't heard anything back since the stop work violation order was issued.

Health Officer Report: Not present.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated the bank balance is \$221,850.13; Mary will be taking the next three Fridays off; CMP will cover the wires at the garage by 9/23; The money to pay Dirigo Engineering was moved from the Road Reserve Savings account to pay the first bill for the Fitch Road Bridge project.

Other Agenda Items:

-Sara Bullard from the Broadband Committee presented a survey that they would like to use to send out to the Townspeople asking about their internet needs and desires. Sara wasn't completely satisfied with the way the survey looked so she is going to work with Tom Johnston to see what low cost options or funding that might be available; Tom suggested that Sara reach out to Charlotte Henderson to get the word out.
